St Dominic's Centre Mayfield has extended to include education to students from Kindergarten through to Year 12. This promotes greater opportunities for students to access more and varied aspects of the curriculum, and also changes the perception of St Dominic's in the community.

This prompted consideration to other changes to the St Dominic's identity and a name change to be more reflective of the modern-day St Dominic's, where students are supported to reach their potential by providing holistic education enabling them to lead a fulfilling life post-education.

The new name 'St Dominic's Catholic College Mayfield', is consistent with other Diocesan secondary schools and the evolved approach at St Dominic's, being at the core of Catholic Education in preparing young adults for life post-school.
